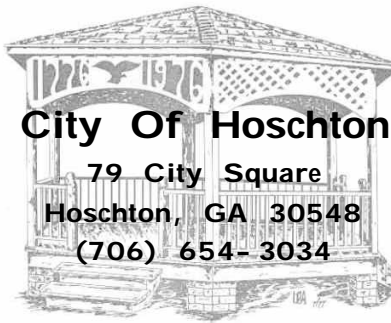

Hoschton Cleanup Days Wednesday through Friday April 23, 24 & 25, 2008

Trash

For residents of the City of Hoschton, special dumpsters will be available in the field beside City Hall. These dumpsters will be for disposal of trash items around your home. They are not to be used to dispose of hazardous waste such as oil or antifreeze.

Appliances

We will also have a trailer at City Hall for you to dispose of appliances. We recommend you call to ensure there is space on the trailer to accept your appliance before you deliver it. Proof of residency within the city limits of Hoschton will be required.

Electronics

Electronics – computers, monitors, televisions and printers – may be left at City Hall to be recycled rather than tossed into landfills.

Brush and Leaves

During these three days only, city employees will provide no-cost curbside pickup of yard items such as brush and leaves. Leaves must be bagged; brush should not be longer than four feet and tied in bundles if appropriate. You must contact City Hall to schedule this service before placing the items at your curb. Do not place these items in the street.
