

# NEW JCWSA OUTDOOR WATER USE GUIDELINES EFFECTIVE APRIL 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009

The Georgia EPD has granted an easing of outdoor watering restrictions. The JCWSA is now at Level 4b until further notice. The following activities are allowed:

- Addresses ending with an **odd** number may use outdoor irrigation systems and sprinklers on **Mondays** and **Wednesdays**, between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 am.
- Addresses ending with an **even** number may use outdoor irrigation systems and sprinklers on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays**, between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 am.
- JCWSA customers are also allowed to wash their cars and perform pressure washing activities at any time.
- Additionally, JCWSA customers may also hand water using one garden hose for twenty-five minutes per day between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00am. Soaker hoses and drip irrigation watering is allowed during these hours as well, and days for these watering activities are restricted to the customer's odd or even address.
- Commercial exemptions allowed under Rule 391-3-30.05 remain in effect and are as follows:
  - Certified or licensed landscapers during installation and thirty days following installation.
  - Irrigation contractors during installation and as needed for maintenance.
  - Sod producers.
  - Fruit and vegetable growers.
  - Retail garden centers.
  - Hydro-seeding.
  - Construction sites.
  - Producers of food and fiber.
  - Commercial car washes.
  - Licensed pressure washers.
  - Watering-in of pesticides and herbicides on turf.
  - Other activities essential to daily business.
