

Effective May 1st the Jackson County Water and Sewerage Authority will be going from Level 2 to less restrictive Level 1 Drought Restrictions

Use is allowed according to the schedule below		
Outdoor Water Use	Odd Addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9)	Even Addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8)
Spraying irrigation, lawn sprinkling, athletic fields, and golf courses (excluding tee boxes and greens)	Allowed Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday Except no watering between 10am and 4pm	Allowed Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday Except no watering between 10am and 4pm
All other outdoor water uses including: a. Non-commercial vehicle washing, including charity car washes b. Filling and topping off of private and public swimming pools c. Other non-essential outdoor uses of water such as hosing sidewalks and pressure washing by homeowners	Allowed Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday Anytime	Allowed Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday Anytime
Exempt outdoor water uses: a. Commercial pressure washing and car washing b. Watering of food gardens c. Drip irrigation or soaker hose d. Hand watering with a shut-off nozzle, or handheld container e. Hydroseeding f. Installation and maintenance of an irrigation system g. Irrigation of newly installed plantings (for the first 30 days) <i>Permit Required</i> h. Plants for sale, resale, or installation i. Golf course tee boxes and greens j. Water from private source such as a well, if source is on property to be watered k. Commercial agriculture l. Capture and reuse of cooling system condensate m. Gray water reuse n. Reclaimed wastewater by a designated use with and <i>EPD permit</i>	Any day Any time	Any day Any time
